Class 6 are holding their Reading Café on Monday afternoon at 1.45pm and hope family members can join them.

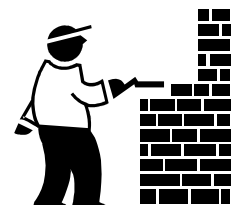
Mother's Day

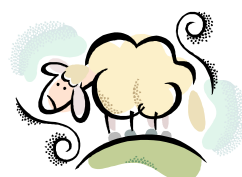
One of our family's Spanish au-pair would like to practice her English. Could you help? Do let Mrs Paul or the office know if you might be able to.
