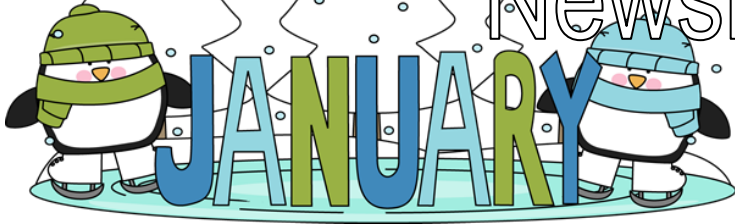

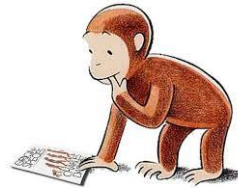
### Cold Weather
